Cases: Initial statements and variables

Case introduction

The project "Royalplatz 7" is a new construction project with a total of 21 residential units and three commercial units with a weighted living area of approx. 2,350m² in Stockerau, close to the city limits of Vienna. In addition, 36 parking spaces are allocated to the residential units. The flats have large open spaces (private gardens, balconies and terraces) and face south, east and west. The floor plans of the flats are in line with modern requirements and vary from 2 rooms (up to 4 rooms (approx. 114 m²). The objective of this crowdfunding campaign is to partially redeem the capital invested for the first phase, with a milestone of € 984864.

The development project is located in the area of Landstraße 1, and this new Royalplatz 7 project will be located in the old town of Stockerau. It is impressive in terms of architecture, social amenities (meeting and communication area), functional floor plan solutions and residential character. Numerous local suppliers, banks, doctors and facilities for daily needs are in the immediate vicinity.

The project is characterised by an environment with high development potential, as well as an experienced project developer and an excellent network. Investors receive an annual interest rate of 6.50% on their invested capital. The interest is distributed to investors every year. The invested capital is reimbursed to investors at the end of a maximum term of 24 months.

- Annual distributions: During the term, the lender will receive an annual distribution of 6.50%.
- In the short term: The lender will receive his invested capital after the realisation of the individual units. According to the planning, this will take place after a maximum of 24 months.



Statements and random variables
